Five successive days at sea — eleven days at sea out of the last thirteen. Internet unavailable much of the time. Ship's entertainment choices limited. Encapsulated on a floating town with 320 sexagenarians / septuagenarians and octogenarians [thank you, spell check; we had no idea how to spell that middle one] plus 150 insufferably-perky young people (the crew). We're headed for the Chilean mainland (Arica) after leaving Easter Island. Our trip has less than a month to go (seems like a lot, still, until you consider we've been on this ship since Feb 1).
