After an extended period at sea, we've finally made it back across the Pacific and cruised northward along the South American coast, stopping at several working ports along the way — Arica, Chile; Lima, Peru; and Manta, Ecuador. Surprisingly, the coast is mostly desert — water comes from aquifers or rivers only. And, even though it's at the equator, the Antarctic Humboldt current keeps the weather mild.
